


- 1. Mount the couplers to the ceiling using appropriate fasteners -NOT INCLUDEDaccording to the structure of the ceiling - see Fig.1
- 2. Pass the aircraft cables through the caps see
- 3. Fasten the caps to the couplers
- 4. Lift the fixture and attach the loose ends of the Aircraft Cables to the cable gliders -see Fig.1
- 5. Make all necessary wiring connections and attach the canopy to the junction box using the bracket/nipple/finial assembly provided.
- 6. Level the fixture using the cable gliders. To release the grip lock, press down on the tip of the mechanism. If desired, clip the excess aircraft cables after the fixture is level.

Note: The canopy is used to cover the branch circuit/junction box.

> **IMPORTANT NOTE FOR FIXTURES WITH LED:** - DO NOT TOUCH THE LED.



FIXTURE DESCRIPTION: MICRO RING. MICRO RING DE. MICRO RING SE. MICRO RING II

- Place the fixture on a flat surface.
- 2. Attach the ceiling plate to the junction box and make the wiring connections coming from the remote box to the terminal blocks.
- 3. Lift the fixture and insert the long aircraft cables into the cable gliders on the hub (Fig. 3) as well as on the gliders on the ring. Ensure that the aircraft cables and power cords are passing through the canopy and hub cover.
- 4. Adjust height of the fixture, secure the power cord with the strain relief provided or use cables ties, and trim or coil inside the canopy the excess power cords.
- 5. Make all necessary electrical connections, lift canopy cover into position and secure with 3x screws.






Conduit (BY OTHERS)

Note: According to the options type, the fixture can have one or two power cords.

WHEN 2 CANOPIES ARE PROVIDED PLEASE INSURE THAT THEY ARE CONNECTED TO THE SAME POWER SUPPLY BRANCH CIRCUIT.



- Place the fixture on a flat surface.
- 2. Lift the ceiling plate with aircraft cables, make the wiring connections inside the junction box, and attach the ceiling plate to the junction box.
- 3. Lift the fixture and insert the long aircraft cables into the cable gliders on the hub (Fig. 3) as well as on the gliders on the ring. Ensure that the aircraft cables and power cords are passing through the canopy and hub cover. Important:

The angled aircraft cables attached to the ring (Fig. 4) must protrude 1 inch only beyond the glider.

- 4. Adjust height of the fixture, secure the power cord with the with cables ties, and trim or coil inside the canopy the excess power cords.
- 5. Make all necessary electrical connections, lift canopy cover into position and secure with 3x cable clamps and set screws.
